**Where**           Tenas Lakes

**When**            October 1, 2000

**Field Trip Coordinator(s):** Mary Phototrekker

**Field Trip Description:** Photography hike past Benson Lake to Tenas Lakes on the trail from Scott Lake to Scott Mountain. Five mile hike (round trip)

**Field Trip Difficulty/Special Challenges/Risks:** Easy to moderate difficulty (depending on physical condition; elevation gain about 600 feet in 2.5 miles. No special challenges or risks.

**Photo Ops:** Reflections in mountain lakes, glacial smoothed rock formations, wild flowers. If the weather lends itself and there is time, views of the Three Sisters from Scout Lake.

**Additional Information:** Check 100 Hikes in the Central Oregon Cascades by William L. Sullivan (3<sup>rd</sup> Ed) (Hike 45, pp 112-113)

**Meeting Place and Timeline:** Target parking lot (NE corner) to pool rides. Leave at 8:30 am Scott Lake parking area off McKenzie Pass Highway (242). Arrive Scout Lake parking about 9:30; lunch at Tenas Lakes; return to Scott Lake parking about 2:30; return to Target parking lot 3:30 pm or later.

### **What to Bring:**

**Food:** Bring a sack lunch/drink for lunch break at Tenas Lakes.

**Clothing:** Suggested dress is layers; be prepared for hot or damp weather. Mornings can be cool and afternoons can be warm to hot.

**Other:** Insect repellent, suntan lotion and extra liquid as needed.

**Amenities:** Portable restroom at Scott Lake parking lot.

**Return:** Cars can determine what time to leave for home; check with the driver before leaving in the morning.

**Sign-up / Maximum Number of Participants:** No sign-up or limit to number of participants; be ready to leave Target parking lot by 8:30 am or you may be left behind.
